The Arts in Festival Hall will transform the Si View Community Center Gym into an 80 seat Toulouse Lautrec style Café showcasing artisans throughout the Snoqualmie Valley. Come to The Arts in Festival Hall and find:

- 🎨 A relaxing environment for enjoying Huxdotter Coffee and pastries from George's Bakery
- 🎨 A stage in the middle of the Café featuring Gary Schwartz's Valley Center Stage Theatre players starring, among others, the Cascade Jazz Trio and the Valley Dolls, led by Harley Brumbaugh. The Café will host live entertainment all three days of the festival
- 🎨 Displays from the 80 member Sno-Valley Quilting Club
- 🎨 A flower show sponsored by the Snoqualmie Valley Garden Club
- 🎨 Featured art displayed on kiosk-style hanging areas surrounded by artists drawing period costumed models
- 🎨 Artists in Action located on ten foot carpeted circles with demonstrations of ceramists throwing pots, weavers at their looms, tie-dyers, a world famous counted-cross stitcher, oil paint and water color demonstrations, et cetera
- 🎨 A large display of student art as selected from our middle schools and high school
- 🎨 The unveiling of the 35 foot Coffee House Mural owned by the City of North Bend to be featured in the new City Hall. Visitors can have their photos taken in period costume in front of the mural.
