Invitation to Submit Entries and Official Contest Rules

“Dreams of The Future”

Open to Mount Si High School and Two Rivers High School students, clubs or school sanctioned groups. When submitting artwork for contest consideration, you, your club, group and members agree to abide by the following rules:

1. Eligibility

All submissions are the work of students in Mount Si High School or Two Rivers High School student clubs or school sanctioned groups.

2. Adherence to Theme

- Entry evokes our theme of “Dreams of The Future” in a form suitable to use as a table centerpiece
- Entry reflects each student, club or group in their theme interpretation. (*Examples: demonstrate a desire to become an artist by painting a scene that expresses these aspirations; express their future dreams by welding an abstract design; build a robot; create a headform to show an interest in cosmetology.*)

3. Submission guidance

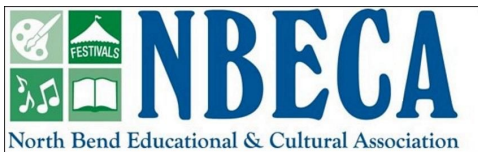
- No larger than 18” in diameter at the base, no higher than 18”
- No smaller than 12” in diameter at the base, with a minimum height of 12”
- Winning student, club or group will receive a \$100 check from NBECA
- Entry must be generally stable and not easily tipped over
- No electricity will be supplied
- Open flame and live animals will NOT be allowed
- Entries containing water MUST NOT leak
- One entry per student, club or group
- With permission, entries may be raffled or auctioned that evening to benefit our scholarship program.

4. No Copyright Infringement

All work must be released for individual usage or purpose usage grants. All entries must contain copyright-free art or art released for entrant’s and public use. No unauthorized use of any copyright images, text, or other material will be accepted.

5. Deadlines

- ✓ **Entries must be received by midnight, Friday, February 17th, 2017**
- ✓ Registration Forms may be emailed to jennyritchey@uwalumni.com or postmarked by the registration date to NBECA, PO Box 1170, North Bend, WA 98045
- ✓ **Entries must be delivered to Park Street Healing Arts, 318 E Park Street in North Bend, by 5pm on Monday, March 20, 2017** along with your name, title of the artwork (if applicable) and 100 word or less description of your interpretation of the theme and how that determined your choice of expression.

6. Judging Criteria

This section describes general guidelines for what our judges are looking for in approving your entry and its award merits. Before submitting your entry for consideration, please understand the following guidelines:

Appropriate Content

- ✓ Content should evoke the theme “Dreams of the Future”
- ✓ Content should be appropriate for and follow your school’s guidelines.
- ✓ The content and design should be unique and original.

Judging will take place on the evening of the event by NBECA’s Board of Directors and all decisions are final.

7. General Use Permission

With your entry, NBECA is given permission to share images of the winner and their winning submission on our website, social media and printed materials.

8. Reserves the Sole Right to Determine Eligibility

Each entry will go through an approval process to determine if the artwork meets our criteria before the entry will be available for judging. Entries that do not meet our criteria will not be included in the contest and will be returned to the submitting student, club, or group.
